*Set-Jetting in Style*, the latest offering from Luxury Backpackers, is a guide-book focussing on worldwide the film locations that have inspired people to travel. In the usual Luxury Backpackers style, the book doesn't cover obvious locations, but has chosen destinations that are 'off the beaten track' as well as a few that are accessible and close to home. Featuring over 200 pages from 8 different locations around the world, including U.K, Spain, Greece, South Africa, The Caribbean Islands, India, Cambodia and USA.

*Set-Jetting in Style* is ideally suited to independent travellers who are fanatical about films, featuring films from romantic comedy to action adventure, which also reveals top-secret film locations and stylish places to stay, eat and explore. The book features detailed coverage of over 60 films including blockbuster movies, as well as independently made films from action films like Lara Croft: Tom Raider to musicals like 'Mama Mia!

Chapters are neatly divided into 6 different genres to suit all tastes, including easy navigable contents page showing the different genres of film and their locations such as:

- Action + Adventure
- Romantic Comedy
- Epics + Historical
- Science Fiction
- Musicals
- Crime + Gangster

Jill and Carlo Nash have personally overseen every detail of the book's design and production, resulting in one of the most creative and well-researched books for any film and travel fanatic. Commenting on the book they say: "During our globetrotting adventures we realised we had actually visited many well-known film locations – some we knew about others we didn't. Whether they were filmed due to their unusual location, timeless history or fabulous scenery, they were special for a particular reason. We wanted to publish this book to let people know about these fabulous film locations, and not just to publish information about the location but also about the places to stay, eat and things to do when you get there."

"We know some travellers will trek high mountains or spend serious money in casinos just because they watched a film featuring their favourite actor, be it Angelina Jolie, Harrison Ford, Sean Connery or Brad Pitt. Travellers may aspire to that particular lifestyle or are captured by the fantasy of their favourite film, and just travelling to the location, seeing where it was filmed and where their favourite actors 'hung-out' makes the dream feel real".

- Delicious local places to eat and sample local food and soak up the atmosphere
- Hot tips on 'where to spot the stars'
- Stylish essentials page with all the information to book and plan your trip

**Notes to editors:**

- Dr. Jill Nash has always had a passion for films from an early age, and remembers her Mum confiscating 'Grease' at the age of 8, after watching it thousands of times over. In the past her work has included 2 years volunteering for the Commonwealth Film Festival, working alongside Micheal Burke and Micheal Fox – two of the UK's most successful media producers - as well as globetrotting to fabulous film locations that have inspired her to travel. One of her favourite films is 'Le grand bleu' starring Jean Reno, which inspired her to explore the worlds most legendary dive sites.
- Carlo Nash, the resident photographer, cannot hide his obsession for films and their locations. Every time a new film is released he buys premier seats in advance, and has watched his favourite film 'The Godfather' countless times, because of his passion for all things Italian. During a trip to Cambodia he spent 2 whole days trying to photograph Ta Prohm (the temple used in Lara Croft: Tomb Raider) to capture it in the best light, not to mention hours of waiting for wildlife to awake in the Kruger National Park. The film which inspired him to travel most recently is the Bond film Casino Royale, where Carlo just had to nip over to the Bahamas!
